Facilities Report: Loading Docks

To make disposing of your rubbish easier, we have listed below all the areas that contain rubbish removal and the separation of each. Westfield has 6 loading docks which have some form of Waste collection as listed below.

These Docks are:

Dock 1 – Located behind Food court and McDonalds drive through. It has a White cage for Card Board recycling and Red bins for Glass bottles, plastic containers and Cans.

Dock 2 – Located behind the male toilets near food court. There is a baller

in the corner for card board collection. Dock 2A – Located behind Crazy Clarks. There is a compactor for General Rubbish, 5 large blue bins for Card board recycling, 5 stands for plastic wrap recycling and Red bins for Glass bottles, plastic containers and Cans. Dock 3 – Located behind Gilhooleys. There is a compactor for General Rubbish, 5 large blue bins for Card board recycling, 5 stands for plastic wrap recycling and Red bins for Glass bottles, plastic containers and Cans. Dock 8 – Located behind Bargains Plus. There is a compactor for general rubbish, a white cage for Card Board recycling, 3 stands for plastic wrap recycling and Red bins for Glass bottles, plastic containers and Cans. Dock 9 – Located behind Best and Less. This dock has 5 stands for Plastic Wrap recycling and a White Cage for Car Board recycling.

What can go in each bin?

The white cages, large blue bins and the Bailer all take cardboard and paper for recycling. They can not take any plastic, foam or any other material including food material.

The red bins can take plastic bottles, glass bottles and jars and aluminium cans.

The compactors take general waste which consists of everything else, except large stocky items. Example: TV's, PC's, cupboards and glass panes. If there are any questions please contact the Centre Management office on 07 3205 4499.
